

Shakespeare's Secret REGISTRATION FORM

St Benet's Hall, 38 St Giles, Oxford OX1 3LN, is adjacent to the historic centre of Oxford, facing on to St Giles, at the junction of the northbound Woodstock and Banbury roads. Owned by Ampleforth Abbey in York, the house is early 19th century, substantially modernised, and has a pleasant garden at the back. The Hall and its history can be viewed at www.st-benets.ox.ac.uk.

All options include seven nights full board (continental breakfast, buffet lunch, 3-course dinner). The options are double or single accommodation in St Benet's Hall, with or without en suite facilities. Please check the option you prefer below.
